Ex-post facto sanction, in relaxation of Jammu and Kashmir Civil Services (Medical Attendance-cum-Allowance) Rules, 1990, is accorded to the reimbursement of medical expenses incurred by Mtr. Hajra Begum on the treatment of her son namely Sahil Ahmad Mir at St. Stephen's Hospital, New Delhi, subject to fulfillment of following conditions:

- 1. Reimbursement of charges is restricted to items / procedures admissible under Rule for the period of hospitalization at St. Stephen's Hospital, New Delhi, from 9<sup>th</sup> March, 2015 to 11<sup>th</sup> March, 2015 and cost thereof is restricted to the extent of rates applicable to such items / procedures at AIIMS, New Delhi.
- 2. All relevant medical bills / vouchers are verified and countersigned by the competent medical authority of the hospital wherefrom treatment has been undertaken.
- 3. Follows up (s), if any are regulated under rules.
