A detailed review on overall assessment of the situation pertaining to the spread of COVID 19 across JK-UT was conducted. There is significant improvement in situation and need of further improvement in the interest of public health especially for students.

In view of the above, and on the basis of current assessment of COVID-19 in JK-UT, it is hereby ordered that:

- a. All schools shall remain closed till 31-07-2021.
- b. However, such staff of education institutions as are needed by the concerned District Disaster Management Authorities / District Magistrates for official duties shall not be exempted from duties on account of this order.

c. Homework for online classes and its daily reporting.

- d. Digital Education Programme(s) "e-Vidalaya/e-Gash" & (e-resources) of Ministry of Education, GoI, "anytime anywhere learning" in addition to Tele & Radio classes shall continue.
- e. Community classes shall be taken regularly as per prescribed guidelines.
