Subject: Regularization of I/C Lecturers (Deferred Cases) as Lecturer in the discipline of **Botany, Computer Science, Chemistry, Physics, Information Technology and Zoology** in School Education Department.

On the recommendations of the Departmental Promotion Committee constituted vide Government Order No. 115—GAD of 2019 dated 23.01.2019, sanction is hereby accorded to the regularization of I/C Lecturers (Deferred Cases) as Lecturer in the discipline of **Botany (10), Computer Science (09), Chemistry (04), Physics (04), Information Technology(9) and Zoology (10)** detailed in Annexure-“A” to this order in the relevant pay scale, as revised from time to time, with effect from the dates indicated against each subject to the following conditions:-

The regularization is without prejudice to the outcome of any writ petition pending in any competent court(s) of law or any case pending in Vigilance or Crime Branch

**The regularization is further subject to the following conditions:-**

- i) That the mode of acquiring degree (i.e. 10+2+2 for those who enrolled or completed first degree course prior to 04.06.1986 or 10+2+2 with bridge course or 10+2+3) as well as the genuineness of P.G. Certificates/Institutions from which he/she has acquired such degree are valid. However, that in light of the clarification issued by UGC vide letter No. 1-15/2015(CPP-II) dated 17.08.2015 to the UGC Regulation notification dated 25<sup>th</sup> November 1985 officials who had enrolled themselves in the first degree course prior to June 4, 1986 in (10+2+2) mode and who had successfully completed their first degree course, prior to June 4, 1986 irrespective of their duration shall be treated at par with those who have completed 03 years degree course and they are not required to undergo a further one year bridge course.
- ii) That Drawing & Disbursing Officers shall take an undertaking from the concerned Lecturer in a shape of an affidavit duly attested by the 1<sup>st</sup> Class Magistrate to the effect that if his/her service particulars/PG Certificate is found



fake/forged/tempered or issued by un-recognized University or the course is proved as un-recognized at a later stage, he/she shall have no claim for the regularization and the regularization order issued in his/her be treated as cancelled ab-initio without further notice.

- iii) That to re-verify that the concerned have acquired P.G Degree after availing the leave during his/her studies/obtained the proper permission, as the case may be.
- iv) The Drawing & Disbursing Officers will obtain LPC and other related details (I, ii & iii above) from the Drawing & Disbursing officer of their parent Institutions concerned before fixing the pay of these Lecturers in the relevant pay scales as revised from time to time.

The Drawing & Disbursing Officers shall be responsible for implementation/fulfillment of above conditions in letter and spirit.


