3. All the codal formalities are completed before incurring any expenditure.
4. The Department shall send utilization certificates of the funds released as early as possible and definitely well before 31-03-2017 to Government of India with a copy to Finance Department / Administrative department.
5. The accounts of the Society shall be open to check by the Accountant General / Finance Department as well as the officers of School Education Department at any time.
6. That the Red Account of the previous drawals and current sanctioned amount is furnished to the Accountant General at an appropriate time.
7. Chief Accounts Officer of the RMSA shall vouch safe the utilization of funds as per Codal procedure / Government of India's guidelines.
