Whereas, vide Government Order No: 08-Edu of 2015 dated:15-01-2015, all the attachments/deployments of teaching staff viz. Lecturers/Masters/Teachers at any level were revoked and accordingly Director School Education, Jammu/Kashmir was directed to relieve the attached staff immediately to their original places of postings;

Whereas, petitioners filed the above titled writ petitions challenging Government orders and subsequently, relieving orders thereof and the Hon'ble High Court while disposing of these cases has directed the Commissioner/Secretary to Government, School Education Department to give a fresh look to Government order No: 08-Edu of 2015 dated: 15.01.2015 and Government Order No: 169-Edu of 2015 dated: 16.4.2015;

Whereas, the Government with a view to ensuring universal education has been opening and upgrading schools in remote areas, in addition to the cities and towns etc.;

Whereas, in a bid to provide quality education, the Government has taken a series of measures to provide the required infrastructure and manpower to the schools;

Whereas, an employee holding transferable post has no right to insist that he/she should be allowed to serve at a particular place for a particular period. Transfer is generally a condition of service and employee has no choice in the

matter. Transfer from one place to other is necessary in public interest and efficiency in the public administration. Whenever a public servant is transferred, he must comply with the order;

Whereas, in terms of Rule 27 of Classification Control and Appeal Rules, 1956, a member of a service or class of a service may be required to serve in any part of the Jammu and Kashmir State in any post borne on the cadre of such service or class;

Whereas, Hon'ble Full Bench of J&K High Court Srinagar vide order dated: 31.8.2015 in SWP No: 1476/2014 c/w SWP No: 1481/2014 and SWP No: 1630/2014 has held that the government servant has no enforceable right to insist that he/she shall be permitted to serve for a minimum of two years in a station or post;

Whereas, transfer of a Government servant from one place to another place is an incidence of service and does not effect or alter the terms and conditions of service;

Whereas, the issue of transfer and postings has been considered time and again by the Hon'ble High Court and the Apex Court, and the entire law is settled by catena of decision of the Apex Court. It is settled law that transfer of a Government servant appointed to a particular cadre of transferable post from one place to the other is an incident of service. No Government servant, therefore, has any legal right for being posted at any particular place;

Whereas, vide Government Order No: 622-Edu of 2015 dated: 22.12.2015, transfer policy of the Department was issued. In the given transfer policy categories have been identified for special provision and general principles have been laid down;

Whereas, vide Government Order No: 26-Edu of 2016 dated: 02.02.2016, upon review of attachments/deployment of staff in the school education department, series of measures have been taken to make the schools functional

Whereas, matter has been examined by the Department and it has been found that Government order No: 08-Edu of 2015 dated: 15.01.2015 has been purely issued in the larger public interest as the said order does not contain any malafides or is in violation of rules of service;



Whereas, the department has further issued Government Order No: 26-Edu of 2016 dated: 02.02.2016 whereby general directions have been issued to the Directors and others field functionaries for detachment of attached officials to rationalize the human resources and provide the teaching faculty in the schools;

Now, therefore, in compliance of the directions of the Hon'ble High Court, case(s) of the petitioner(s) have been examined with reference to transfer policy issued vide Government Order No: 622-Edu of 2015 dated: 22.12.2015 and Government Order No: 26-Edu of 2016 dated: 02.02.2016, with due consideration of the facts germane to the individual and the decision has been indicated in the Annexure "A" to this order.

It is further ordered that in the cases where the claims have been found genuine for suitable adjustment, Director School Education, Jammu shall pass the necessary orders within three days positively and where the claims are assessed to be in-genuine and stand rejected, officials are directed to immediately join the place where they have been transferred within three days failing which appropriate disciplinary proceedings shall be initiated by the concerned Director without any further notice.
