2. All relevant medical bills/vouchers shall be got verified and countersigned by the competent medical authority of the hospital wherefrom treatment has been undertaken.
3. Certificate from the competent Medical Authority (Director Health Services/Principal GMC/other) is obtained to establish the genuineness of the treatment availed in the said hospital.
4. Follow-up(s) if any shall be regulated under rules.



Whereas, a meeting regarding above captioned subject was held on 07-02-2022, in the office chambers of Principal Secretary to Government, School Education Department, attended by Director School Education Jammu/Kashmir, Additional Secretary to Government (SED), Deputy Secretary to Government (M), Deputy Secretary to Government (U) and Nodal Officer HRM Section;

Whereas, it has been noticed that confusion is created in considering seniority of Masters posted as Head Teachers in the upgraded Middle Schools;

Whereas, in the Jammu and Kashmir Education (Subordinate) Recruitment Rules notified vide SRO-308 dated 16-10-2008, there is no post of Head Teacher;

Whereas, Teachers promoted as Masters were posted in the upgraded Middle Schools at the time of their promotion and were given nomenclature of Head Teacher;

Whereas, to fix seniority of Master cadre, these Head Teachers have to be considered and included in the seniority list of Masters as at the time of their promotion;

Now therefore, in view of above facts, all the Head Teachers shall be placed in the seniority list at appropriate place in the Master cadre as per seniority for affecting their promotion hence forth so that DPC for promotion of Masters is done.




