Subject:- **Exoneration of Mr. Aijaz Ahmad Andrabi, retired I/C Principal, HSS, Samboora, Pulwama from charges leveled against him.**

**D a t e d: 10 -02-2022**

1. Whereas, Mr. Aijaz Ahmad Andrabi Lecturer was posted in GHSS, Kapran, Shopian during the year 1991-92 and had drawn an amount of Rs. 12000/- vide T.V No 14 dated 01.01.1992 on account of LTC. However, the accused had failed to submit the vouchers/documents in connection with his LTC and on this basis a case was registered and investigation was set into motion by Anti Corruption Bureau, J&K.
2. Whereas, During the investigation the relevant records were seized and it was found that an amount of Rs. 12000/- was sanctioned and received by the accused but he could not undertake the journey nor did he refund the amount within 30 days as per rules in view of the fact that his brother who was putting up in Delhi in connection with business passed away suddenly during the said period.
3. Whereas, Mr. Aijaz Ahmad Andrabi had refunded the amount of LTC advance in the Treasury after a lapse of 4 ½ years. However, no departmental enquiry has been conducted against the accused retired Officer.
4. Whereas, Mr. Aijaz Ahmad Andrabi has approached the School Education Department through a medium of representation dated 03.06.2021 stated wherein that he has refunded an amount of Rs. 12000/- and has requested this Department to exonerate him from charges leveled against him.
5. Whereas, the matter was examined in the Department and vide this Department's letter No.Edu-HRM/46/2021-01 Dated 06.07.2021, the representation alongwith its enclosures, submitted by Mr. Aijaz Ahmad Andrabi, Rtd I/c Prpl, HSS, Samboora, Pulwama was forwarded to General Administration Department with a request to furnish all related documents of the case, so that the Department shall take necessary action in the matter.
6. Whereas, the General Administration Department vide letter No. GAD-VIGOCOMP/28/2021-09-GAD (part-I) dated 03.08.2021 has taken up the matter with Anti Corruption Bureau, J&K, Srinagar.



7. Whereas, the Director, Anti Corruption Bureau, J&K, Srinagar vide letter No. ACB-FIR-18/1995-K-21169-70 dated 29.09.2021 has forwarded the requisite information/documents related to the case FIR No. 18/1995 P/S VOK (now ACB) for further course of action.

8. Whereas, on examination the case, the matter was again taken up with General Administration Department vide e-file bearing No.Edu-HRM/46/2021-01 Dated 03.11.2021 for seeking its advice in the matter.

9. Whereas, the General Administration Department vide U.O No.GAD-VIGORDA/168/2021-02-GAD Dated 14.01.2022 has advised as under:

**"On examination of the case in the General Administration Department it has been observed that the case attracts provisions of Article 168-A of J&K CSRs, as per which the initiation of departmental proceedings against the official, having retired in the year 2018, are not viable at this stage.**

**The Department is advised to conclude the case accordingly by issuing a speaking Government Order and furnish ATR to GAD".**

10. Now, therefore, in light of the advice of the General Administration Department and the documents furnished by Director, Anti Corruption Bureau, J&K, Srinagar, the case of Mr. Aijaz Ahmad Andrabi, Rtd I/c Principal HSS, Samboora, Pulwama cannot be pursued further and hence charges leveled against him are hereby dropped on the ground of his superannuation.

6. That the electrical components are authenticated by the Competent Authority;
7. That encumbrance free land is available for execution of the project;
8. That the Lump sum provisions, either in terms of percentage or fixed as made for certain components are provisional and shall be subject to detailed estimates of cost based on actual measurements, requirements and relevant rates on the basis of specified specifications and make, to be framed and approved by Competent Authorities before invitation of tenders in accordance with set codal procedures;
9. That e-tendering mode is followed for fixation of Award of contract for execution of the project and working DPR is followed in the formation of BOQ for e-tendering purpose of the project. Fragmentation of the project, while tendering, is not allowed;
10. That proper rate analysis and market survey is conducted in light of standing rules and procedures in case of all the items, proposed to be executed on ground, prior to issuance of formal NIT for the project, in order to ensure rationality of rates;
11. That the payments have been/are made as per actual quantity & measurements approved specification/ makes on reasonable rates with adherence to set Codal procedure;
12. That all the components executed including those through SICOP have been approved by the competent authority.
13. That any such item(s) not covered under relevant schedule of rates shall be paid in accordance with the set Codal Procedure; and
14. The stipulation as prescribed for Energy efficient/ rain water harvesting/ green building are adhered to.
