In terms of Rule 6 of J&K Civil Service (Medical Attendance-cum-Allowance) Rules, 1990, sanction is hereby accorded for reimbursement of medical expenses in favour of Smt. Babita Bhagotra, Master, Govt. GHS Chack Jaralan, Bishnah, Jammu incurred on her own treatment at Rajiv Gandhi Cancer Hospital, New Delhi subject to the following conditions:

- Reimbursement of the claim shall be admissible only for expenses incurred beyond the package cost admissible under the PMJAY SEHAT scheme as per Health Benefit-Package applicable at the time of treatment for such treatment/procedure.
- Reimbursement of charges shall be restricted to items/procedures admissible under 2. rules for the period of hospitalization only.
- All relevant medical bills/vouchers shall be verified by the relevant medical authority 3. of the hospital where treatment was provided.
- An essentiality certificate on Form-2 of J&K Civil Service (Medical Attendance-cum-Allowance) Rules, 1990, issued by the hospital authorities, shall be obtained and kept 4. on record.
