In terms of Rule 6(1) of J&K Civil Service (Medical Attendance- cum-Allowance) Rules, 1960, post facto sanction is hereby accorded to the reimbursement of medical expenses in favour of **Mohd Ayaz Iqbal Mughal, Principal Govt. HSS Chanti** incurred by him on treatment of his son at Institute of Liver and Biliary Sciences, New Delhi during the period of hospitalization, subject to the following conditions:


1. Reimbursement of charges shall be restricted to items/procedures admissible under rules for the period of hospitalization and cost thereof shall be restricted to the extent of rates as applicable to such items/procedures at AIIMS New Delhi.
2. All relevant medical bills/vouchers shall be got verified and countersigned by the competent medical authority of the hospital where from treatment of the patient has been undertaken.
3. Essentiality Certificate on Form 2 issued by the hospital authorities.
4. Dependence of the patient on the official is established under rules.
